PROBLEM STATEMENT


In today's rapidly evolving digital era, digital literacy is no longer optional—it's essential. Unfortunately, a significant digital divide exists between students in Uttarakhand's state government schools and their counterparts in private institutions. This gap is starkly evident in the disparity of access to digital tools and internet facilities.

While an impressive 77% of private schools in Uttarakhand are equipped with computers and 52% have internet access, only 29% of state government schools have computers, and a mere 6% have internet facilities. This digital deficiency profoundly impacts the economically disadvantaged students who primarily attend these government schools, depriving them of vital opportunities to develop the necessary 21st-century skills.



Our mission is to bridge the digital divide by empowering disadvantaged students in Uttarakhand with the tools and skills needed to succeed in the digital age.



We envision a digitally literate and sustainable Uttarakhand, where every child has access to the latest technology, 21st century skills, and values-based education irrespective of their socio-economic background.



The SPEED bootcamp is a 10-day residential program for socially and economically disadvantaged students in grades 6th to 8th from state government schools in Uttarakhand. It focuses on digital literacy, English grammar, and lifelong learning, with IGNITE, a subpart exclusively for girls, offering a non-residential program. Both aim to empower students through interactive activities and technology, fostering holistic development.






E-UTSAHITA

KEY HIGHLIGHTS

Transformative Results from Inaugural SPEED Bootcamp - JAN 2023

From January 1st to January 12th, we conducted a 10-day residential bootcamp for 34 disadvantaged students from 8 government schools. significantly enhancing their digital literacy, coding, and **English-speaking** abilities through practical experience. Results showed remarkable improvements, with digital literacy soaring from 21.18% to 75.88%, coding scores reaching 57.35%, and English-speaking skills increasing from 39.49% to 45.66%.





Inauguration of First KDG in Dwara - APRIL 2023

On 30th April, KSDS inaugurated the inaugural Kalpavriksha Digital Gurukul in Dwara village, Raipur block. Operated by our SPEED bootcamp graduates, who act as agents of change, the center has trained 44 students (33 UPS and 9 PS) in basic digital literacy and Scratch Programming to date.




KEY HIGHLIGHTS

Scaling Impact through SBC 2.0 - JUNE 2023

After the resounding success of our inaugural bootcamp, we launched the second edition, SBC 2.0, held from June 5th to June 16th. Over the course of 10 days, we welcomed 21 disadvantaged students from 7 government schools to a residential program aimed at boosting their digital literacy, coding, and English- speaking skills through hands-on experiences. The outcomes were impressive, with digital literacy surging from 21.43% to 63.81%, coding proficiency reaching 48.21%, and English-speaking abilities rising from 30.86% to 39.84%.




KEY HIGHLIGHTS

Piloted Readpreneur Youth Inititative -December 2023

The Readpreneur Youth Initiative provides weekly live online group classes, offering underprivileged youth the chance to delve into various literary works centered on entrepreneurship, financial literacy, and life skills. Kicking off with a cohort of 6 students, we embarked on the Wonder novel by R.J. Palacio. This initiative resulted in notable improvements in their spoken English, reading, writing, enriched vocabulary, and presentation abilities.






Empowering Girls in Technology - January

From January 1st to January 10th, we extended our reach by welcoming 60 disadvantaged girl students from 4 government schools to a non-residential bootcamp. Our focus was on advancing the UN goal of gender inclusivity in technology by enhancing digital literacy, coding, and English-speaking skills. The results were striking, with digital literacy jumping from 23.94% to 48.56%, and English-speaking proficiency rising from 41.38% to 44.30%.
